

LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

E ACKNOWLEDGE THAT WE ARE gathered today on the traditional lands of the Anishinaabek (Auh-nish-in-ah-bek), Haudenosaunee (Ho-den-no-show-nee), Lūnaapéewak (Len-ah-pay-wuk) and Attawandaron (Add-a-won-da-run).

We acknowledge all the treaties that are specific to this area: the Two Row Wampum Belt Treaty of the Haudenosaunee Confederacy/Silver Covenant Chain; the Beaver Hunting Grounds of the Haudenosaunee NANFAN Treaty of 1701; the McKee Treaty of 1790, the London Township Treaty of 1796, the Huron Tract Treaty of 1827, with the Anishinaabeg and the Dish with One Spoon Covenant Wampum of the Anishinaabek and Haudenosaunee.

This land continues to be home to diverse Indigenous people (First Nations, Métis and Inuit) whom we recognize as contemporary stewards of the land and vital contributors to society. We hold all that is in the natural world in our highest esteem and give honor to the wonderment of all things within Creation. We bring our minds together as one to share good words, thoughts, feelings and sincerely send them out to each other and to all parts of creation. We are grateful for the natural gifts in our world, and we encourage everyone to be faithful to the natural laws of Creation.

The three Indigenous Nations that are neighbours to London are the Chippewas of the Thames First Nation, Oneida Nation of the Thames and the Munsee-Delaware Nation who all continue to live as sovereign Nations with individual and unique languages, cultures and customs.

This Land Acknowledgement is a first step towards reconciliation. Awareness means nothing without action. It is important that everyone takes the necessary steps towards decolonizing practices. We encourage everyone to be informed about the traditional lands, Treaties, history and cultures of the Indigenous people local to their region.



INDIGENOUS HERITAGE: EXPLORING THE LAND & HONOURING TRADITIONS

Want to learn more about the Indigenous history of the area and admire First Nations art? We've compiled a few of London's top Indigenous heritage offerings for you to enjoy.



MUSEUMS AND EXHIBITS

Ska-Nah-Doht Village and Museum, nestled within Longwoods Road Conservation
Area, just 30 minutes west of London, offers a window into Haudenosaunee life about 1000 years ago. Guests can explore outdoor exhibits offering insight into the rich heritage of this local Indigenous community. With its longhouse village and museum, visitors will immerse themselves in the outdoors, experience cultural belongings and learn about conservation efforts.

The surrounding 155 acres of Carolinian forests known as Longwood Road Conservation Area offers ten kilometers of accessible trails, wetland boardwalks, a pavilion and picnic areas. The museum also provides a space for birdwatching and wildlife observation.



EXPLORE MORE

When downtown, be sure to check out the stunning murals by Hawlii Pichette (Urban Iskwew) in Market Lane.



The Museum of Ontario Archaeology (MOA)

is dedicated to exploring and preserving Ontario's deep archaeological heritage. Located beside the Lawson Site, a 500-year-old Indigenous village and National Historic Site, the MOA cares for millions of archaeological objects from across the province and offers exhibits, programs and tours that highlight over 13,000 years of human and natural history. Visitors of all ages can engage with Ontario's past through hands-on activities, educational programs and seasonal events. The museum's gift shop also features books, clothing and art by local First Nations creators.



KNOWLEDGE SHARING THROUGH THE ARTS

Tourism London's Welcome Centre at 696 Wellington Road offers up a unique setting for an Indigenous Art Gallery with work by local artists including Annette Sullivan, Brenda Collins, Chandra Nolan, Mike Cywink, Oscar Marroquin-Ponce, Renee Jewell and Steve Maracle.

Their artwork represents various themes that speak to Indigenous worldviews and experiences and are created from diverse materials including textiles, beadwork, cedar, porcupine quills, birch bark, acrylic and glass.

There are also two mosaic murals installed on the south exterior wall that signify the ongoing and historical relationship of the local First Nations communities to each other and to the surrounding communities. The murals help to situate visitors to the city and locals alike to the traditional territory of the Indigenous peoples.

INDIGENOUS MURALS AT THE EAST LIONS COMMUNITY CENTRE

The mural **Firekeeper**, created by Ojibwe educator and visual artist Mike Cywink, adorns the exterior-facing windows near the entrance of the East Lions Community Centre. It's the first in a series of stained glass-style murals across the city, developed through the Songlines Project.

Inside the centre, **Way of Life - Bimaadziwin**- **Tsi' niyóht tsi tyúnhe'**, by Anishinaabe
educator and visual artist Nancy Deleary,
surrounds the fireplace and is the first artistic
interpretation of a Wampum Belt in London.



Whether you're interested in strolling through art museums, visiting the birthplace of medical marvels, brushing up on military history or getting up close and personal with a historic jet aircraft, London has a diverse selection of museums waiting for you to explore!

Located in the historic Wolseley Barracks, the Royal Canadian Regiment Museum houses two floors of interactive exhibits and countless artifacts from Canadian military history. Walk through time and discover the story of the Royal Canadian Regiment from the 1800s through to the present day. Although the site is still home to active military headquarters, visitors are always welcomed at the museum.



Discover the fascinating history of the modern Royal Canadian Air Force at the **Jet Aircraft Museum** and immerse yourself in military and aviation artifacts. Step inside the hangar and get up close with historic aircrafts or take to the skies and experience the thrill of flying in a vintage training jet!

CULTURE



Want to learn more about the top-secret side of World War II? **The Secrets of Radar Museum** tells the story of the thousands of Canadians who served in all aspects of radar. The museum features several impressive physical exhibits as well as a large research archive that, until recently, nobody was allowed to know about!



For a dose of inspiration and a glimpse into the medical heroes of Canada, we prescribe a trip to the **Canadian Medical Hall of Fame**. This museum, dedicated to honouring those who have made lasting contributions in medicine, celebrates close to 150 Canadians whose contributions advanced the medical field in Canada and around the world.

Did you know that the birthplace of insulin is right here in London, Ontario? Take a guided tour of the **Banting House Museum** and **National Historic Site** and don't forget to grab a photo in front of "The Flame of Hope" monument outside the house. This eternal flame will burn until a cure for diabetes is found.



Uncover the mystery and charm of the **Eldon House**, London's oldest residence. Overlooking the forks of the Thames River, this 1834 home holds rich history and tradition. Explore the historic property at your own pace with a self-guided tour and be sure to take a stroll through the beautiful gardens outside which have been re-created just the way the Harris family kept them.

Focused on the rural communities and townships of London and the surrounding area from 1820-1920, **Fanshawe Pioneer Village** is where the past is present. A recent addition is London's historic fugitive slave chapel. Dating back to 1848, the chapel was London's stop on the underground railroad.



The **Holy Roller** is a powerful symbol of bravery and sacrifice. Persevering from D-Day on June 6, 1944, through the end of the Second World War in Europe on May 8, 1945, this tank stands as a testament to the courage of those who served.

The $1^{\rm st}$ Hussars Regiment, a storied regiment based in London and Sarnia, endured immense hardships during the war, with 346 tanks and 207 soldiers lost. The Holy Roller, rescued from the scrapyard, was returned to its home station in London, Ontario. Presented to the City of London in 1949, it became a memorial in Victoria Park, honoring the regiment's veterans. After years of deterioration, in 2018, a global campaign helped fund its restoration and in May 2022, it was returned to the park just in time for the $150^{\rm th}$ anniversary of the $1^{\rm st}$ Hussars.

Try Toboggan Brewing Co.'s Holy Roller Lager, with a portion of proceeds going to the Holy Roller Memorial Preservation Project. Available at local LCBOs and on tap at select London establishments.



With an extensive collection, **Museum London** is the perfect stop for the art enthusiast. Located in downtown London, the museum features over 5,000 regional and Canadian artworks and more than 45,000 artifacts. With works ranging from beautiful landscapes by The Group of Seven and contemporary abstract paintings, to exhibits examining the history of London, there's always something to discover.




Looking for a fun and educational experience for kids? The London Children's Museum has expanded into brand-new larger space designed specifically for young minds to learn, play and explore. Now housed in 100 Kellogg Lane, this 36,000 sq ft museum offers a variety of hands-on exhibits that engage children in history, culture, science Learn more about and more. 



The renowned **Aeolian Hall**, a converted Town Hall known for having some of the best acoustics of any performance space in Canada, is home to a variety of touring acts.



Located on the side of the **Grand Theatre**, Ola Volo's **Queen and the Dove** is a striking 18x16 meter mural that tells a story of empowerment,

meter mural that tells a story of empowerment, nature and new beginnings. The Queen, representing Mother Nature, and the Dove, symbolizing confidence and strength, inspire viewers to embrace their identity with pride.

Capturing an iconic moment in London's music history, **Johnny & June** is a breathtaking three-story mural located on the north side of **Canada Life Place**. On February 22, 1968, Johnny Cash proposed to June Carter at the London Gardens, creating a timeless link to London, Ontario. Renowned artist Kevin Ledo brings his signature splash of colour to the "Man in Black," immortalizing a larger-than-life moment into something equally unforgettable.

If your feed focuses on the bright, the vibrant and the outdoors, you won't want to miss a stop at the **Market Lane Murals** in the downtown core. Painted as a part of the theme "Forest City Playground," Market Lane is home to four stunning works of art by three talented artists all incorporating the theme in their own, distinct way.

Also a part of the "Forest City Playground" theme, **Hamilton Road's Neighbourhood Laundromat Café Mural** showcases an art piece as bold and lively as the neighbourhood it's in. The message of "Explore the Forest" motivates people to explore new and different areas of London. While you're there, check out the interactive angel wings on the opposing side of the building and grab a snack from inside the café to perfect your post.

London's Old East Village (OEV) is home to some of the city's most stunning murals. The **OEV Main Street Mural Program** features five unique displays made by five teams of artists, each with their own distinctive style.













As a UNESCO City of Music, London has a special musical heartbeat that can be found all throughout the city. **The UNESCO**City of Music murals serve as colourful greetings to those arriving or departing the London VIA Rail station, the London International Airport and RBC Place
London. Whether you're travelling, attending an exciting gathering or simply passing by, capture a moment with these murals and showcase London's musical identity in your next IG story!

Clayworx: Ceramics Arts Learning Centre has also done their part in beautifying OEV by facilitating gorgeous mosaics. Made up of three large panels, **Hope, Love and Belonging** uses 12,000 handmade tiles to depict the Thames River and blossoming Ontario wildflowers. Other displays like the **Gateway Mosaics**, **Wayfinding Mosaics** and **Canada 150 Mosaic** similarly bring together thousands of meticulously crafted tiles into cohesive and intricate designs that transform Dundas Street into an outdoor gallery that's worthy of a post on your social channels.





NSPIRING AWE AND IMAGINATION, THE MUSEUM'S treehouse village and explorable cave system allow children to connect with the world around them and make new discoveries. In the space-themed exhibit, visitors can command a rocket launch with an interactive mission control panel and experience a star show that will have their imaginations soaring into the cosmos.

This expanded museum now offers endless opportunities for exploration. Vibrant murals by artists Mike Cywink and Hawlii Pichette add to the inviting atmosphere, while a stunning mural by Susan Day celebrates community and creativity, making a memorable backdrop for learning and play.

New standout exhibits include *Stream*, a 21-metre-long water table inspired by the Thames River, where kids can learn about water flow and human impact on nature. *Farm Works* highlights London's agricultural history, letting children engage with pulleys, gears and chutes to discover how food goes from farm to market.

In *Unearthed*, young explorers can dig up dinosaur bones and minerals, then investigate and research their finds in the field lab, perfect for hands-on learning and discovery.

The London Children's Museum is as much a visual journey as it is a space for play.
