LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

WE ACKNOWLEDGE THAT WE ARE GATHERED today on the traditional lands of the Anishinaabek, Haudenosaunee, Lūnaapéewak and Attawandaron.

We acknowledge all the treaties that are specific to this area: the Two Row Wampum Belt Treaty of the Haudenosaunee Confederacy/Silver Covenant Chain; the Beaver Hunting Grounds of the Haudenosaunee NANFAN Treaty of 1701; the McKee Treaty of 1790, the London Township Treaty of 1796, the Huron Tract Treaty of 1827, with the Anishinaabeg, and the Dish with One Spoon Covenant Wampum of the Anishnaabek and Haudenosaunee.

This land continues to be home to diverse Indigenous people (First Nations, Métis and Inuit) whom we recognize as contemporary stewards of the land and vital contributors to society.

The three Indigenous Nations that are neighbours to London are the Chippewas of the Thames First Nation; Oneida Nation of the Thames; and the Munsee-Delaware Nation who all continue to live as sovereign Nations with individual and unique languages, cultures and customs.

This Land Acknowledgement is a first step towards reconciliation. Awareness means nothing without action. It is important that everyone takes the necessary steps towards decolonizing practices. We encourage everyone to be informed about the traditional lands, Treaties, history, and cultures of the Indigenous people local to their region.

INDIGENOUS HERITAGE: EXPLORING THE LAND & HONOURING TRADITIONS

Want to learn more about the Indigenous history of the area and admire First Nations art? We've compiled a few of London's top Indigenous heritage offerings for you to enjoy.

Ska-Nah-Doht Village and Museum



MUSEUMS AND EXHIBITS

Nestled in the forest just west of London, **Ska-Nah-Doht Village and Museum** offers a window into Haudenosaunee life about 1000 years ago. Guests can explore outdoor exhibits offering insight into the rich heritage of this local Indigenous community. Tour the longhouse village and museum, learn about conservation efforts and experience the outdoors.

The site is located within the **Longwoods Road Conservation Area**, a beautiful 155-acre Carolinian forest. With over 10 kilometres of accessible trails, peaceful wetland boardwalks, picnic areas and scenic spots for birdwatching, a visit here is a great way to pair cultural exploration with time in nature.

The Museum of Ontario Archaeology

The Museum of Ontario Archaeology (MOA) is dedicated to exploring and preserving Ontario's deep archaeological heritage. Located beside the Lawson Site, a 500-year-old Indigenous village and National Historic Site, the MOA cares for millions of archaeological objects from across the province.

Through engaging exhibits, guided tours, hands-on programs and seasonal events, visitors of all ages can discover over 13,000 years of human and natural history. Before you leave, stop by the gift shop, which features books, clothing and artwork created by local First Nations creators.



KNOWLEDGE SHARING THROUGH THE ARTS

Tourism London's Welcome Centre at 696 Wellington Road is a unique setting for an Indigenous Art Gallery. The space contains work by local artists including Annette Sullivan, Brenda Collins, Chandra Nolan, Mike Cywink, Oscar Marroquin-Ponce, Renee Jewell and Steve Maracle.

Created from diverse materials including textiles, beadwork, cedar, porcupine quills, birch bark, acrylic and glass, their artworks reflect themes that speak to Indigenous worldviews and experiences.

Two mosaic murals installed on the south exterior wall also signify the ongoing and historical relationship of the local First Nations communities to each other and to the surrounding communities. The murals help situate visitors and locals alike to the traditional territory of the Indigenous peoples.

INDIGENOUS MURALS AT THE EAST LIONS COMMUNITY CENTRE

The mural **Firekeeper**, created by Ojibwe educator and visual artist Mike Cywink, adorns the exterior-facing windows near the entrance of the East Lions Community Centre. It's the first in a series of stained glass-style murals across the city, developed through the Songlines Project.

Inside the centre, **Way of Life - Bimaadziwin - Tsi' niyóht tsi tyúnhe'**, by Anishinaabe educator and visual artist Nancy Deleary, surrounds the fireplace and is the first artistic interpretation of a Wampum Belt in London.

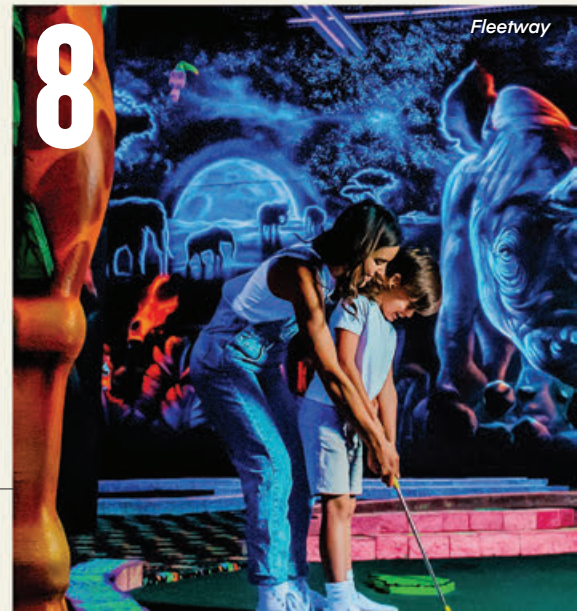

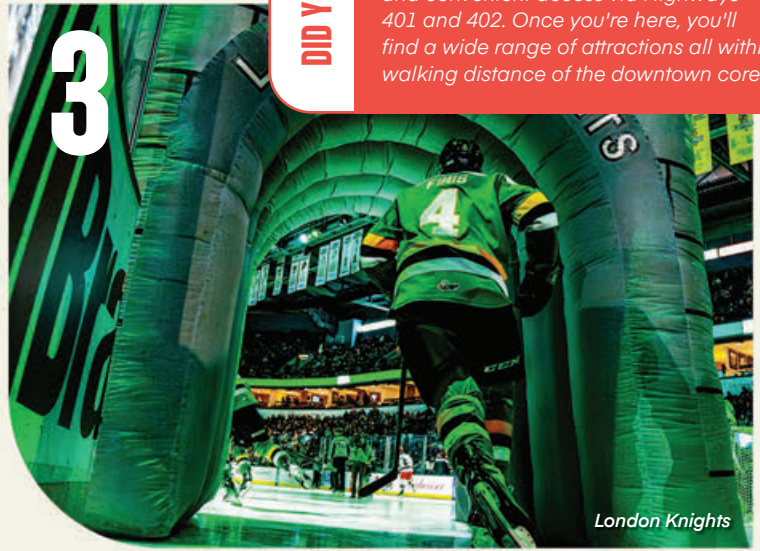

From the team behind the award-winning **Yaya's Kitchen** supper club, Chefs Malvin and Maryam invite visitors to savour the story behind each bite. The café crafts plates, pastries and pours inspired by the history and artistry of Black food communities, reflecting a rich tapestry of global influences.



Michael Gibson Gallery

From exhibition launches and guided tours to hands-on workshops and meet-the-artist moments, these evenings of free or low-cost events let you authentically uncover the local art scene. As you stroll between venues in the warmer months, you'll find vendors set up along **Dundas Place** and discover independent artists creating in London.

Anchoring the crawl are downtown galleries like **TAP Centre for Creativity**, an artistic hub that engages creatives with monthly exhibitions, artist-led tours and drawing classes. Steps away, **Michael Gibson Gallery** exhibits contemporary Canadian art and **Jonathon Bancroft-Snell Gallery** draws collectors and curious visitors with Canada's largest contemporary ceramic collection.

FANSHAWE PIONEER VILLAGE

The past becomes present at **Fanshawe Pioneer Village**. This open-air, living history museum tells the story of London and the surrounding area from 1820-1920. Explore 19th century homes, watch demonstrations and even visit the historic African Methodist Episcopal Church that acted as a stop on the Underground Railroad.



ELDON HOUSE

Uncover the charm of **Eldon House**! London's oldest residence was built in 1834 and overlooks the forks of the Thames River. Take a self-guided tour of the historic property and stroll through the beautiful gardens carefully recreated the way the Harris family kept them.



BANTING HOUSE NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE

Skipping ahead into the 20th century: did you know that London is the birthplace of insulin? Take a guided tour of **Banting House National Historic Site** to see the home where Sir Frederick Banting dreamed of an idea that would change the world. Grab a photo in front of the Flame of Hope monument, which will burn until a cure for diabetes is found.

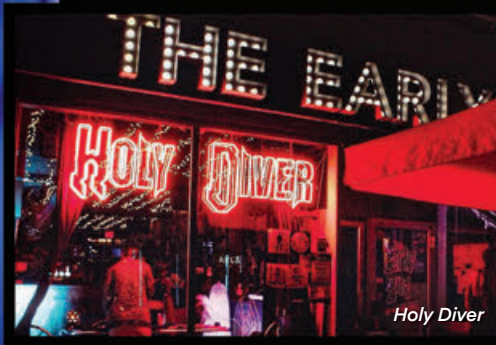
EVENING ENTERTAINMENT

Live performances sit at the heart of London's nightlife, with shows often becoming the centerpiece of a great night out. From huge headliners and touring favourites to hot new acts, the spotlight never goes dark.

Canada Life Place anchors the scene with stadium shows that echo rock and country anthems throughout downtown. The newly enhanced **London Music Hall** and **Rum Runners** stages offer a more intimate setting for an eclectic mix of performers across genres. The addition of **Comedy & Co.** to this space brings stand-up and improv into the mix, adding a jolt of laughter into London's nightlife.

Aeolian Hall, a beautifully restored former town hall, is celebrated for its exceptional acoustics and refined performances, while **Wolf Performance Hall**, the **Grand Theatre** and **Centennial Hall** entertain with theatre, concerts and cultural programming that feels both elevated and welcoming.

A collection of local staples like **Honey Dip** and **Holy Diver** build out the scene with stripped-down DIY performances that keep London's alternative culture loud and alive. Soak in the musical legacy of the **Richmond Tavern** or head to **Palasid SocialBowl** for a unique live music experience featuring a steady lineup of touring bands.
